Take a Step Back When You Feel Unsafe

I want to empower you to walk away from a situation you feel could put you or others in danger of contracting or spreading COVID-19. Town staff members are working diligently to ensure there are proper safety protocols in place in Town facilities, on Town equipment (including vehicles), and otherwise while personnel are on the job. However, if you feel something has been compromised, someone is not following the protocols, or you are working with someone not employed by the Town and they haven't been instructed to follow the same safety guidance, you have the ability to step away from the situation, speak with your supervisor, and together assess how to complete the assignment with the safety of all parties in mind. Please remember, telework as much as you can, try at all costs to limit in-person meetings (absolutely no more than 10 people meeting in person), wear a mask if you are in a shared space (including hallways and restrooms), and practice common sense hygiene (wash your hands often and don't touch your face with unwashed hands).
