Hello Everyone,

We are experiencing some icy conditions in the region after last night's precipitation and drop in temperatures overnight. There have been a number of motor vehicle crashes in the region, fortunately none so far in Chapel Hill. In the interest of employee safety, I am moving the Town into Condition 2 from 4 a.m. to 10 a.m. this morning. Mandatory employees should report to work as designated. Non-mandatory employees, even if you can work remotely, should not work until 10 a.m. Please refer to the Adverse Events Policy for more information. If you are unclear about whether you are mandatory, please contact your supervisor. If you are mandatory, please use extra care while driving this morning. Black ice has been reported across our region, especially on bridges and overpasses. Our Public Works staff members have already been out this morning applying salt to key areas. It is cold out, though, and slick spots are likely.
